the ball valves of the series **R780P-1** e **R781P-1** dimensions $\frac{1}{2}$ " and $\frac{3}{4}$ ", destined to be used in the following applications and with the following use limits:

- Fluids: water, glycol solutions (max 50%) and non-dangerous gases;
- Temperature range: -20÷120°C (-20°C with glycol solutions at 50%);
- Maximum working pressure at 20°C with water and non-dangerous gases: 1,6 MPa (16 bar)

are properly designed and manufactured using materials suitable to the distribution of water and non-dangerous gases, according to the sound engineering practice in use, which ensures the safety of use in compliance with the technical requirements and the specific prescriptions, pertinent and applicable, referred to art.4, par. 3, of PED 2014/68/UE Directive with particular reference to Tab.7 of Annex II – Conformity assessment tables.

The subject valves are also manufactured respecting design and production processes in compliance with the requirements of **UNI EN ISO 9001:2015** standard.

Moreover, GIACOMINI S.p.A. company ATTESTS,

that the ball valves here identified, in application of the above-mentioned technical requirements and prescriptions, are not "CE marked" since they have characteristics lower than the limits given at paragraph 1, letters a), b) e c) and at paragraph 2 of PED 2014/68/UE Directive.
